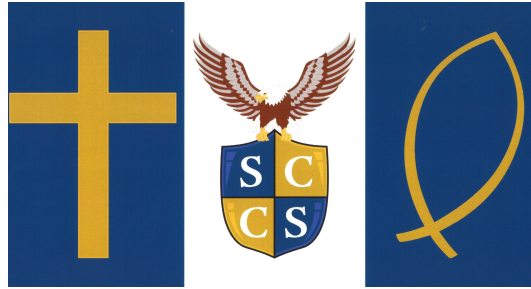


## RATES AND FEES

## **PURPOSE**

As a Christian school, we provide a safe, nurturing, developmentally based environment. We offer a variety of activities and experiences that will help your child develop socially, physically, emotionally, intellectually, and spiritually. Our staff also desires to work together to support parents in the training of their children through resources offered by our church and school.

## **PHILOSOPHY**

Our program is based on the following concepts:

- God has created each child uniquely in His image and has given that child special talents which should be developed and enhanced in a manner that is glorifying to God.
- We value character development as revealed in the Bible. Every class follows a Bible curriculum that helps the child identify Christ-like characteristics that enhance the quality of life. Among these are reverence for God, love for neighbors, kindness, obedience, patience, and honesty. (John 3:36, Romans 10:9, 10).
- Instructional placement should be determined primarily by a child's developmental level.
- Children will develop self-discipline and confidence in their own abilities when they are nurtured.

## **PRESCHOOL PROGRAM**

(Monday-Friday: 9 A.M. - 12:00 P.M.)

We believe each child is a unique individual, created by God, and given special talents. We have developed a program that will allow your child to discover and enhance these talents. By providing a wide variety of interesting and stimulating choices, we further strive to reinforce feelings of success and appreciation of your child's uniqueness.

## **CLASS START TIME**

All classes begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. It is extremely important for your child to be on time to fully engage in and benefit from our entire program. Late students disrupt the entire class. It is very important that your child is on time every day.

## **PRESCHOOL READINESS**

Children must be 2 years old, and display a readiness for large group experiences.

Growth and learning are sequential and orderly processes. Children pass through predictable stages of development at their own pace. Learning experiences will be appropriate for each child's developmental stage, even though it may not necessarily coincide with his/her chronological age.

We provide a program that develops good readiness skills and helps children feel secure and free to enjoy their school experiences.

The preschool program operates year round from September to August. During the summer months, the preschool conducts a well-planned special program that focuses on arts and crafts and physical activity as well as academic activities.

## **EXTENDED CARE**

(Monday-Friday: 7 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.) **Starting on 6/3/2024**

Our extended care program is dedicated to providing our children with warm, loving care in a secure environment. Our purpose is to create an atmosphere that encourages social, emotional and physical growth. We strive to instill spiritual and moral values in each of our children while helping them learn self-discipline.

Extended care is available year round, Monday - Friday with the exception of national holidays, special vacation days, and teacher in-service days.

## **SOCIAL-EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT**

We are committed to promoting and supporting healthy social-emotional development in our preschool program, which studies show is foundational for young children's learning.

**Social interaction** focuses on the relationships we share with others, including those with adults and peers. As children develop socially, they learn to take turns, help their friends, play together, and cooperate with others.

**Emotional awareness** includes the ability to recognize and understand our own feelings and actions and those of other people, and how our own feelings and actions affect ourselves and others.

**Self-regulation** is the ability to express thoughts, feelings, and behaviors in socially appropriate ways. Examples are learning to calm down when angry or excited, or
